- There are 38 congregations in Togo; we expect more with the baptism of Pastor YAMBA WAMA David from a denominational church in Kpadape village as he helps the church change to the church of the New Testament
- One pappy spent 40 years looking for the church of Christ; he found it by the radio program and gave his life to Christ in baptism; two more were baptized the following day
