- Our daughter Leah was baptized!

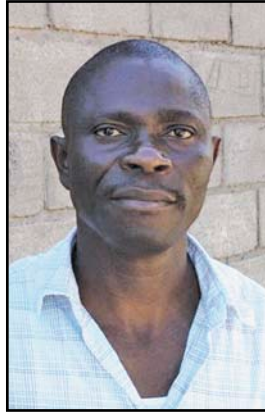
## HAITI

- The revival celebrating Pioneer Church's 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary gave testimonies of what God has done since the start of the congregation and the launch of the radio ministry which started immediately after; two were baptized



- In ten years the radio coverage has gone from a radius of 40 square km. to over 200 square km.; comments from high ranking government personalities indicate that we are really helping to shape the good character of our society
- One listener from Nyamira in Kisii South Nyanza asked us to visit him and start the church in his area
- The radio ministry has blessed us in planting two congregations since April in Kipsegi and Ngendale/Lesirwa with over ten baptisms and restoration of fallen faith in brethren
- I addressed over 2,000 mourners in Lesirwa at the funeral of the late Racho Lelei, a role model for mothers and wives in the village
